



Let's suppose we wanted to make a note here in Philippians 1:25 about another Pauline passage that contains the word μένω. GRAMCORD for Windows has a Personal commentary feature that allows you to append your study notes to the Bible text. Click on New Commentary, then select Commentary Personal. A window will appear with a flashing cursor. You may now enter your own study notes on the current text.

Select the Toggle Resource Edit and Hypertext Mode Button. As you move in the Bible text you may now enter notes on every verse in the Bible. Bible Companion offers additional personal authoring tools in the Personal Topics. This unique reference allows you to enter up to 32,000 topics such as sermon notes, study notes, etc., all with your own personalized index.
